

Basic Skills

Embry-Riddle recognizes the importance of communication and quantitative skills and requires students to demonstrate appropriate proficiency in English and mathematics before enrolling in certain coursework.

Skills assessments and/or placement processes are used to ensure students are enrolled in courses appropriate to their level of preparation.

Basic or preparatory skills courses may be required if proficiency is not demonstrated.

Credits earned in certain preparatory/basic skills courses may not apply toward minimum degree requirements.

Completion of a skills assessment does not guarantee admission to the University; students must meet all admission requirements.

Although basic skills courses are computed into the student's term grade point average (GPA) and cumulative grade point average (CGPA), credits earned in basic skills courses (numbered 001-099) do not apply to minimum degree requirements in any degree program.
