All flight training at Embry-Riddle is conducted in late-model, technologically advanced aircraft, supported by advanced procedures trainers, Advanced Aviation Training Devices (AATDs), Flight Training Devices (FTDs), and Extended Reality (XR) training systems to provide a safe, flexible, and cost-effective environment.

Flight training is an integral part of the Aeronautical Science program but may also be available in other degree programs as a concentration, minor, or elective credit on a space-available basis. Students should confirm course applicability and prerequisite/corequisite requirements before committing resources.
