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## ARBC 101 Arabic I 3 Credits (3,0)

Elementary Arabic language. Oral-aural focus; courtesy phrases; basic vocabulary; question-and-answer patterns. Not open to students with two or more years of high school instruction or native speakers.

## ARBC 102 Arabic II 3 Credits (3,0)

Arabic language speaking, reading, and writing skills. Basic social interactions; describing people, places, and things; personal information; daily activities; and social needs.

Continuation of Arabic studies.
