EVSC 142 Introduction to Environmental Science 3 Credits (3,0)

The interrelations of all aspects of the living and the nonliving world. Introduces the student to key concepts and principles that govern how nature works and the application of these concepts and principles to possible solutions to environmental and resource problems.
