FINE 188 Personal Financial Management 3 Credits (3,0)

Personal financial planning including budgeting, tax return, managing cash and credit, investment decisions and risks, insurance needs, and retirement planning.

FINE 332 Corporate Finance I 3 Credits (3,0)

Finance in management. Financial analysis, planning, short- and long-term financing, risk, return, capital investment, and cost of capital. Focus on aviation-related businesses.

FINE 333 Personal Financial Planning 3 Credits (3,0)

Personal financial planning including budgeting, taxes, managing cash and credit, investment decisions, insurance needs, and retirement planning.

FINE 334 Investment Analysis 3 Credits (3,0)

Investment analysis from the perspective of individual investors. Security markets, investment vehicles, portfolio management, risk and return, valuation, fiduciary responsibility, and ethical conduct.

FINE 342 International Finance 3 Credits (3,0)

Analytical framework for understanding international financial conditions. Cross-border trade, capital flows, inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, monetary and fiscal policy, and economic growth.

FINE 360 Financial Statement Analysis for Engineers 3 Credits (3,0)

Financial statement fundamentals for engineering decision-making; analysis of balance sheets, income statements, and cash flow statements; evaluation of profitability, liquidity, and efficiency; application of financial ratios for project and vendor assessment; use of time value of money concepts; interpretation of financial data to support budgeting, valuation, and investment decisions in technical environments.

FINE 399 Special Topics in Finance 1-6 Credit (1-6,0)

Individual, independent, or directed studies of selected topics in finance.
