This degree offering is for those students wishing to pursue a dedicated curriculum in the field of aviation finance. Students from other majors may be accepted into the program, but would first need to successfully complete 15 hours of undergraduate classes in economics, accounting, finance and business statistics before commencing graduate level classes.
