

A.S. in Aeronautics

The Associate of Science in Aeronautics provides essential knowledge and skills in aviation and related fields. Students learn about aircraft design, flight operations, and aviation safety, which prepare them for professional applications. The online format allows students to learn at their own pace and balance academic study with work and personal responsibilities. Students have access to networking opportunities and resources to connect with potential employers. The program supports students seeking advancement in a current role or entry into the aviation field.

At the **Worldwide Campus**, the Associate in Science is offered in online and on-campus formats, allowing students to take classes in a range of settings and schedules. The curriculum includes principles of aeronautical science, aviation maintenance, transportation, safety, security, history, engineering, and uncrewed systems. Electives and minors allow students to tailor the degree to specific academic and professional interests. Students may apply prior life experience toward more than a quarter of the required semester hours and may complete a bachelor's degree in as few as three years.
