

B.S. in Safety Management

The Bachelor of Science in Safety Management is designed to prepare students to address safety challenges in dynamic regulatory environments. This program is ideal for active-duty military personnel, industry researchers, managers, safety specialists, and individuals with no prior safety and health background who are interested in entering the field.

At the **Worldwide Campus**, the B.S. in Safety Management program is designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills to operate as competent leaders, managers, and practitioners in safety management. Students will develop technical understanding and expertise and a practical and analytical approach to problem solving that will allow them to address industry-related safety challenges in both the public and private sectors.

The Safety Management program is a Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP) Qualified Academic Program (QAP), meeting rigorous standards and offering a curriculum aligned with the Associate Safety Professional (ASP) designation.

Graduates are awarded the Graduate Safety Practitioner (GSP) designation, placing them on the path toward Certified Safety Professional (CSP) certification.

Students may also apply for the Associate Safety and Health Manager (ASHM) credential through the Institute of Hazardous Materials Management (IHMM), streamlining the path to the Certified Safety and Health Manager (CSHM) certification.

The bachelor's degree in Safety Management is an approved Category I – AU-ABC program and appears in the Air Force Virtual Education Center (AFVEC) for selection.
